Places to Visit in Tashkent

- Architectural Complex Zengi-Ata: This is the internment place of Sheikh Aj-Hodzha.
- Abdulkasim Medressah: It was made in the distinction of the incredible Abdulkashim Khan in the nineteenth century.
 It is shut the Parliament of Uzbekistan.
- Barrak Khan Madrassah: This is around the earth walled structures of the city.
- Chorsu Bazaar: It is Tashkent Farmers advertise where under a tremendous dome flavors, grain, Dairy items, tree grown foods of the season. The brilliant individuals of Tashkent could be seen in the bazaar.
- Ensemble Khazret Imam: It is the tomb of one of the first imams of Tashkent. The library has the pieces of the planet's first Quran.
- Khanvendi Takhur Sheikh Mausoleum: This was made in the fourteenth century. The structures was remade in the eighteenth and nineteenth century. It is made of yellow blocks.
- Kulkeldash Mederssa: It is a Quran School. It was inherent the sixteenth century. It was manufactured by the researcher and artist Kulbobo Kukeldash.
- Kaldyrgach-bly Mausoleum: This aged landmark helps to remember the mazars in the Kazakh steppes. The arch is as a pyramid made in the fifteenth century.
- Mausoleum of Zainuddin-bobo Sheikh: This mausoleum is of the child of the originator of a celebrated around the world Sufi holy person. The Old Town is lovely and worth viewing.
- Movie Mubarek Library Museum: This place has saved the planet's most senior Quran.
- Mausoleum of Abubakr Muhammad Kaffal Shashi: This mausoleum is of the first Imam who bit the dust in 976/977. It is rectangular fit as a fiddle and is has a cone shaped arch.
- Tellya Sheikh Mosque: It has numerous original copies and the Osman Quran.
- Yunus Khan Mausoleum: This mausoleum was made in the fifteenth century. It goes once more to the Timurids. Yunus Khan the descendent of Gengiz Khan and granddad of the Indian moghul Babur. It has no embellishment on it with the exception of "panjara" on the primary face of the architecture.
